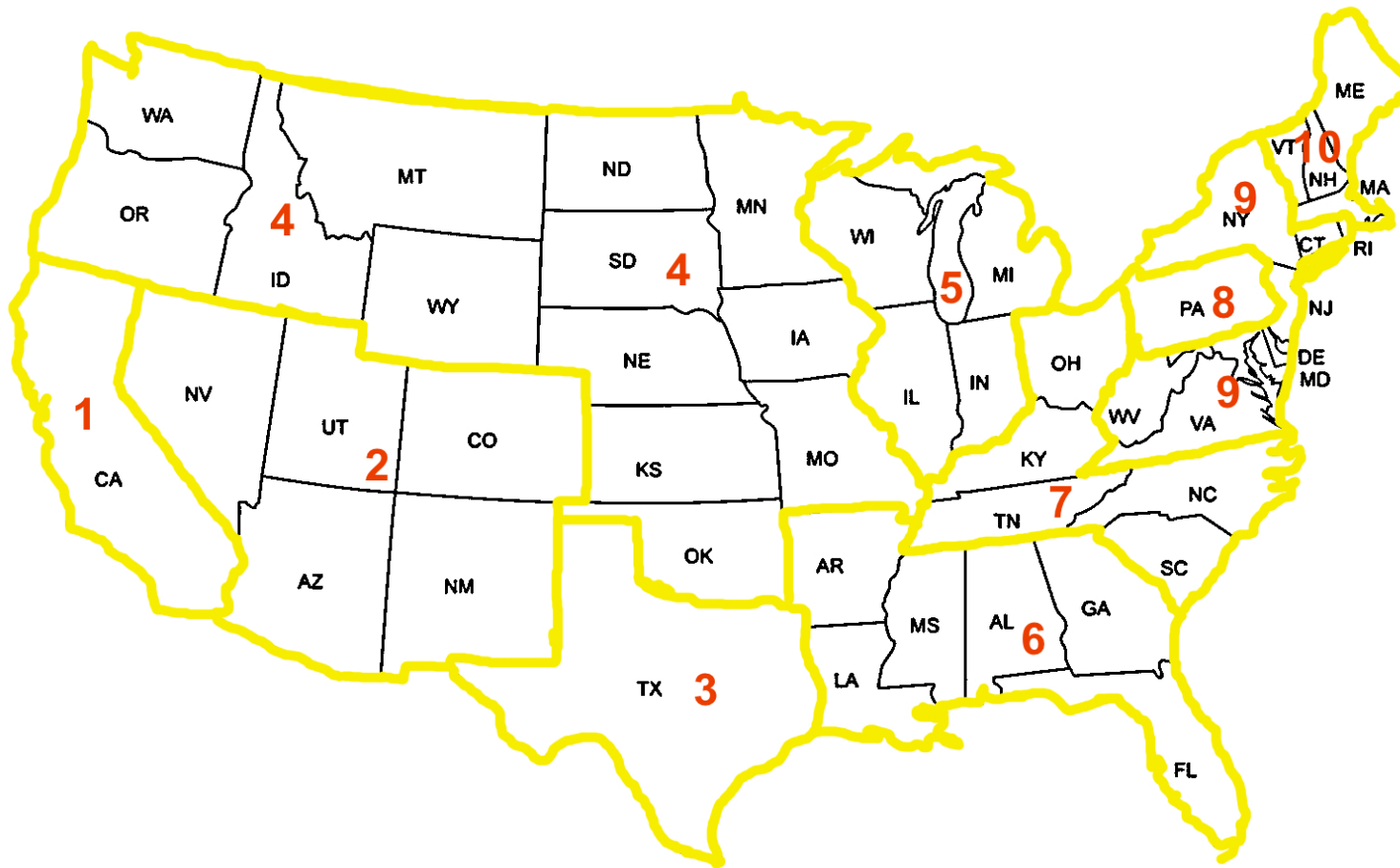

# Course Review Submission Procedure

The new course reviewer map applies to all courses for trials held on or after **September 5, 2017**.

**Course Submission:** When submitting courses for review please consult the course reviewer map and send all your courses in one email addressed to all the reviewers involved.

- **Titling Courses**
  - See the 2017 course reviewer map and submit all your courses to the regional reviewer.
- **Tournament Courses**

  - For tournament only trials you need to include the regional reviewer in your submission email – they track the courses within their region so judges get paid.

**All Courses Submitted in One Email:** All courses are to be submitted in one email addressed to 1-4 reviewers depending on the courses being submitted. Example:

- **Titling** only, no MC/PMC – Regional Reviewer
- **Titling** only, with MC/PMC – Regional Reviewer & [MC@usdaa.com](mailto:MC@usdaa.com)
- **Titling** with MC/PMC, STP/PSJ and/or GP/PGP – Regional Reviewer, [MC@usdaa.com](mailto:MC@usdaa.com) & [GPSTP@usdaa.com](mailto:GPSTP@usdaa.com)
- **Titling** with MC/PMC and TEAM – Regional Reviewer, [MC@usdaa.com](mailto:MC@usdaa.com) & [TEAM@usdaa.com](mailto:TEAM@usdaa.com)

## When are your courses due to the reviewer(s)?

- Judges under supervision – **6 weeks (42 days)** prior to the first day of the assignment.
- Judges off of supervision – **4 weeks (28 days)** prior to the first day of the assignment.

**Late Courses:** If you are unable to get your courses to the reviewers on time it is your responsibility to let the reviewers know **ahead of time**.

**Course Design Information:** Please verify that the equipment list, ring dimensions and class schedule you receive from the groups hiring you are accurate. It is your responsibility to get this information in advance in order to submit your courses on time.
