From the North:

Take I-10 South to the Baseline Rd. exit. Go east on Baseline for approximately 1 mile to Kyrene Rd. Go South on Kyrene a mile to Guadalupe. The park is on the Northwest corner of Guadalupe and Kyrene.

From the South:

Take the I-10 North to Baseline Rd. exit. Go east on Baseline approximately 1 mile to Kyrene Rd. Go South on Kyrene a mile to Guadalupe. The park is on the NW corner of Guadalupe and Kyrene.

From the East:

Take 60 West to the Rural Rd. exit. Go South on Rural Rd. approximately 1.5 miles to Guadalupe Rd. Go West on Guadalupe Rd approximately 1 mile to Kyrene Rd. The park is on the Northwest corner of Guadalupe and Kyrene.

Policy Prohibiting Alcoholic Consumption

No alcoholic consumption or open containers of alcohol are permitted on the grounds. Noncompliance could result in immediate expulsion from the event, legal prosecution under local law or both.

Entries & Acceptance

Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered OR for Sanctioned Match), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA[®] Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com, as [amended](#)

Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 days of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Good Dog Refund Policy

Prior to closing any dog may be withdrawn from the trial with a full refund.

After closing competitors with bitches that come into season or injured/ill dogs shall be refunded the full amount of their entry less the amount owed USDAA. The Trial Secretary must be notified that the dog is being withdrawn prior to the start of the Trial. The dog will be withdrawn for the entire trial. ALL requests for refunded entry fees must be accompanied by a **veterinarian's letter** and must be provided to the Trial Secretary by the close of the trial (close of the trial defined as completion of the last run). All other requests for a refund will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. In most cases refunds for in-state residents will be in the form of a Good Dog Agility credit memo to be used for any dog owned by the handler. Credit memo funds can be used for classes, future events/trials with Good Dog Agility Club. Requests for refunds in the form of a check will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis.

It is the entrant's responsibility to check entries and confirmations for errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellations of entries after the closing date (with the exception listed in the statement above).

Good Dog General Rule of Eligibility

This is a family spectator sport all competitors are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and family oriented manner. (i.e. apparel, appearance, language and demeanor) If aforementioned has been deemed by the Trial Committee as inappropriate competitor must remedy before competing further, if not remedied competitor may be excused from the event without the benefit of a refund.

All data entry and entry form errors found after the closing date and/or after posting of the running order is the sole responsibility of the competitor. If any changes are required by the trial secretary, a service charge fee of \$20 will be required, paid to GDA (no GDA Doggie Dollars permitted) in full prior to the events first run, no exceptions. This \$20 fee is to cover all expenses to change competitor's information.

All entry fees must be paid in full by the initial closing date. Failure to do so will result in removal from the event.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

Next-Day Move-Ups Allowed At This Event

Competitors earning a qualification during the Event that is needed to complete a title may advance their level THE NEXT DAY at the same event, i.e. move-ups on consecutive days ARE allowed.

Competitors are responsible for keeping accurate records of their qualifying scores and the judges from whom these scores were earned prior to this event to ensure that the dog is eligible to move up based upon scores earned at this Event. Competitors are advised to confirm scores earned with the scorekeeper and judge at the conclusion of a class to ensure the qualifying score has been accurately calculated and awarded in accordance with regulations. If for any reason it is determined that the score or previous scores were inaccurate, making the entry ineligible for the higher level class, any results (including awards) shall be forfeited and the entry will be deemed invalid without refund or other recourse.

Move-up forms supplied by this event must be used to notify the secretary BEFORE she leaves the site the day on which you earn your title.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 24" in the Championship Program or 20" in the Performance Program at local and regional events must be measured unless they have a permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration card or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). Please note that only dogs 18 months of age and entered in the event may be officially measured.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In FEO Not Allowed

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor may

- Run the dog at the higher height in the same program based upon the measurement,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Performance Program,
- Modify the entry to enroll the dog in the proper height class in the Veterans Program if the dog is 8 years old

Dogs may NOT run For Exhibition Only (FEO) at this event.

Because entry into a higher height is permitted in the Performance and Championship Programs, a dog measuring lower may not be moved to a lower height in either program.

General Entry Conditions

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Class Descriptions

Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm, and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm, each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more tournament classes are being held at this event, the rules and description of which may be downloaded on the Internet at www.usdaa.com/gen_formDoc.cfm, and are hereby incorporated by reference. A written copy may be obtained from the Event secretary.

Mixed-Height Pairs Entry Allowed

Dogs entered as partners in pairs relay at this event may be combined without regard to jump height, i.e. a mini dog may be entered as a partner with an open dog. Any pair consisting of at least one open dog must qualify in accordance with the QCT set forth by the judge of record for Open Pairs AND will be considered an open pair for placement purposes.

Masters Challenge Biathlon

This Biathlon consists of two classes; Masters Challenge Standard and Masters Challenge Jumpers. While these two classes will count as titling runs, they also form the biathlon where scores will be converted to time plus faults. After the two classes, scores will be combined to calculate those dogs in each jump height earning eligibility by posting an overall score in the top 25%. A dog scoring an elimination in either class will be eliminated from Biathlon award contention.

Veterans Program Classes

Veterans level classes offered at this event are open to a competitor with any dog that is at least eight (8) years of age as of the first day of this event. Previous experience in the sport sufficient to establish proficiency and confidence in performance is strongly encouraged. A dog entered in a Veterans class on a day may not be entered in that class in the Championship or Performance Programs. Tournament and Titling Class Awards:

Title Classes:

First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded in each jump height for all classes, except Pairs where ribbons will be awarded to mini and open classes. A maroon qualifying ribbon will be awarded to those achieving a qualifying score in a test class. Titling rosettes will be awarded to those finishing a title.

Grand Prix/Performance Grand Prix:

First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded in each jump height. A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to those achieving a qualifying score. A Regional Championships bye voucher will be awarded to the first place qualifier in each jump height.

Steeplechase/Performance Speed Jumping:

Qualifying ribbons will be awarded in Round One. Prize money shall be paid in accordance with the rules found at www.usdaa.com. Allocable amounts to the finalist positions that are not filled for any reason shall not be paid.

Biathlon:

First through fourth place ribbons will be awarded. A qualifying ribbon will be awarded to those achieving a qualifying score.
