From the North:

Take 101 S to Carmen Dr Exit. Exit Carmen Dr and turn LEFT off freeway onto E Ventura Blvd. Continue to Carmen Dr and turn LEFT onto Carmen Dr. Continue on Carmen Dr for .6 mile to Burnley St and turn RIGHT.

From the South:

Take 101 N to Carmen Dr Exit. Exit Carmen Dr and turn RIGHT off freeway onto Carmen Dr. Continue on Carmen Dr for .5 mile to Burnley St and turn RIGHT.

Policy Prohibiting Alcoholic Consumption

No alcoholic consumption or open containers of alcohol are permitted on the grounds. Noncompliance could result in immediate expulsion from the event, legal prosecution under local law or both.

Entries & Acceptance

Express & Overnight Entries

Entries sent by Fedex, Express Mail or other courier service will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery **without signature** is signed. The club will not be responsible for deliveries delayed if a signature is required.

No Entry For Exhibition Only

No entry "For Exhibition Only" shall be accepted, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered. See additional note for club policy regarding dogs that measure up.

General Rule on Eligibility

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc. ("USDAA").

This test is open to all persons with dogs being at least 18 months of age (14 months of age pursuant to Chapter 10 for Intro Program when offered OR for Sanctioned Match), regardless of pedigree or absence thereof, who have a current registration with USDAA and whose owners and the dog's handler are currently in good standing with USDAA.

This event will be held under USDAA[®] Official Rules and Regulations, a copy of which may be viewed and printed online at www.usdaa.com.

Policy on Refusal of Entry

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the Committee view that participation by the competitor or dog could be prejudicial to the sport. However, in such case, the Committee must notify the competitor in writing upon receipt of entry, but in no case, more than three days following the event closing date for acceptance of entries. The burden of responsibility for the appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

NSF Check/Credit Card

Any check or credit card that is charged back by the bank or other financial institution may be assessed a service charge of up to \$40 per incident at the discretion of the host group.

Returned checks or credit card returns do not constitute a valid entry. Amounts shall be paid within 30 day of postmarked notice of the returned payment if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes related to the entry for which payment was made. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution.

Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event, or entry is canceled without recourse.

Refund Policy

There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date for acceptance of entries, for absentee, dismissal from the event as a result of disciplinary action, dismissal from a class, or for any other reason. Also, no entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, acts of terrorism, fire, "act of God", public emergency, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the host organization.

Refund for Overpayment

Refund for Overpayment

There will be NO refunds for overpayment of fees. Any overpayment of fees will be donated to a group of DART's choosing.

DART donates 10% of our net proceeds from all agility trials to various canine groups, organizations and funds. Any overpayment of entry fees will be added to the donation we make after each trial.

Submission of Entries with Secondary Move-Up Date

All entries or cancellations must be received at the Secretary's address no later than the closing date, after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled. For entries received by the closing date, the level of entry into a given class may be advanced by notifying the Secretary in writing via email by the "Secondary Closing Date". No other changes, cancellations or additions may be made after the initial closing date.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number on a completed registration form.

Regional - Provisional GP/PGP/STP/PSJ Entries

Provisional entries will be accepted for competitors who have not earned a qualifying score prior to the closing date, which is required for entry to the Regional classes for Grand Prix, Performance Grand Prix, Steeplechase and Performance Speed Jumping. Qualifying opportunity in the Grand Prix/PGP or STP/PSJ through local qualifiers is offered at this Regional Championship event.

A separate payment for provisional entry fees to the tournament classes is required and must be designated on the Entry Form, or such payment will be nonrefundable should the dog not be eligible to run.

Check-in & Measuring

Dog Measurements & Certification

All dogs not jumping 26" in the Championship Program or 20" in the Performance Program at local and regional events must be measured unless they have a permanent USDAA or World Cynosport Dog Registration card or a temporary card with 3 signatures as required by the regulations, making the dog eligible for their jump height (prior to 3 years of age). Please note that only dogs 18 months of age and entered in the event may be officially measured.

Regional - Special Measuring

Competitors whose dog has a temporary height card MUST have the dog measured prior to checking in at any Regional Championship event or Cynosport® World Games in order to confirm that the dog is eligible for the height entered.

If the dog measures up, the competitor must jump the dog at the higher jump height in all classes regardless of the jump height in which the dog earned its qualifications. If the competitor had a bye at the lower height, the bye is forfeited, and the competitor must compete in all rounds that may have been bypassed as a result of the bye.

A Dog that Measures Up at Check-In FEO Not Allowed

If a judge's measurement of a dog at check-in establishes that the dog is ineligible for the height class in which entered, the competitor MUST run the dog at the higher jump height. The dog shall be placed first in the running order for all classes entered. The competitor may not change their entry from one program to another (e.g., from Championship to Performance).

General Entry Conditions

Prohibitions on Aids & Devices

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided for in Chapter 10 when Intro Program classes are offered, or in Chapter 8 when Junior Handler Program classes are offered.

Statement of Responsibility

Competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs, children or guests. A competitor whose dogs, children or guests create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Policy on Fault Limits

In the event of a larger entry, fault limits may be set at the discretion of the Organizing Committee and/or Judge without pre-event notice.

Spam Blocker

Confirmations will be sent via email using the secretary's address. If you have a spam blocker on your email account, please configure it to allow email from the secretary's address since confirmations will be sent from this account.

Class Descriptions

Titling Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more titling classes shall be held at this Event from those described in Chapters 3 - 8 of USDAA Official Rules & Regulations, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm, and any amendments there to, which are downloadable from www.usdaa.com/rulesReg.cfm, each of which are hereby incorporated by reference.

Tournament Class Rules & Descriptions

One or more tournament classes are being held at this event, the rules and description of which may be downloaded on the Internet at www.usdaa.com/gen_formDoc.cfm, and are hereby incorporated by reference. A written copy may be obtained from the Event secretary.

Team & Versatility Pairs Measure-up Policy

The handler of a dog entered in Team or Versatility Pairs must notify the secretary immediately should their dog be required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measurement. The dog must jump the higher jump height in order to be eligible to earn a qualifying score in the tournament. If entered in Team, the dog may not be moved to Versatility Pairs. If the handler chooses **not** to have their dog jump the higher height, their entry is effectively withdrawn. The competitor may or may not run for exhibition only (earning no qualifications) solely at the discretion of the event secretary; there shall be no refund of fees paid.

If the change in height makes the dog ineligible for their team (three jump heights), the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from dogs available. A move-up in height for dogs in Versatility Pairs does not affect their team composition, but may result in a change in their position in the running order because of the height composition of the Pair.

Masters Challenge Classes - Championship & Performance

All dogs - regardless of level of competition - are eligible for entry in the Masters Challenge classes and to earn qualifying scores. These qualifying scores will remain on the dog's record and calculate toward Masters Challenge titles once the dog achieves the Masters Standard / Masters Performance Standard and Masters Jumpers / Masters Performance Jumpers titles.

Additionally, these dogs continue to be eligible for their appropriate level in the regular classes at all levels, unless stipulated otherwise in the Agility Test Schedule. Competitive placements in the Masters Challenge Standard and Jumpers classes accumulate points for annual ranking for Agility Top TenSM and Performance Top TenSM.

Masters Challenge Biathlon

This Biathlon consists of two classes; Masters Challenge Standard and Masters Challenge Jumpers. While these two classes will count as titling runs, they also form the biathlon where scores will be converted to time plus faults. After the two classes, scores will be combined to calculate those dogs in each jump height earning eligibility by posting an overall score in the top 25%. A dog scoring an elimination in either class will be eliminated from Biathlon award contention.

Prizes & Awards

Tournament Awards

Masters Challenge/Perf. Masters Challenge Jumpers/Standard: DART will offer a Rosette for first through fourth in each jump height. A maroon qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all competitors earning zero faults.

Local Grand Prix/PGP Qualifier: DART will offer a Rosette or Ribbon for 1st through 4th place in each jump height. A maroon qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all competitors earning zero faults. The first place qualifier in each jump height shall receive a regional bye voucher.

Local Dog Agility Steeplechase® and Performance Speed Jumping Qualifier: A maroon qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all competitors earning a qualifying score in Round 1.

Regional Grand Prix/PGP: Maroon qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying scores in round 1. Finals - first thru third rosettes/medals will be awarded in each jump height; a Regional Champion Trophy for first place; and semifinalist rosettes.

Regional Steeplechase/PSJ: Maroon qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying scores in round 1. Finals - first thru third rosettes/medals will be awarded in each jump height; a Regional Champion Trophy for first place; and semifinalist rosettes. Prize money will be awarded pursuant to the distribution chart found in the online tournament rules and include a percentage of the entry fees from BOTH Round 1 of the local qualifier and Round 1 of the Regional.

Team and Versatility Pairs: First through third place medals for overall in each tournament as well as a Regional Championship trophy for first place team members overall.

Masters Challenge Biathlon/Perf. Challenge Biathlon: Maroon ribbons and first thru fourth place rosettes will be awarded for each jump height in individual Masters Challenge classes. First through third place medals will be awarded for each jump height for the overall Biathlon winners. A Regional Champion trophy in each jump height will be awarded.

Provisional Entries

Eligibility Notification for Provisional Regional Entry

If you have entered the Regional Grand Prix/Performance GP and/or Regional Steeplechase/Speed Jumping on a provisional basis, written notification of eligibility MUST be given to the secretary of record no later than noon on Monday, April 20th, prior to this regional championships. This notification may consist of confirmation that the dog is eligible for the regional classes entered OR that the local qualifier(s) entered at the regional is still needed for eligibility. If no notification is given, you will forfeit provisional entry fees. Notification must be made via emails to vapordog@earthlink.net with a read receipt. The secretary cannot be responsible for undelivered/misaddressed emails.

Tournament Eligibility Notification at the Event

Should a dog earn eligibility for Round 1 or Round 2 of the Regional Grand Prix/Performance GP or Round 1 of the Regional Steeplechase/Speed Jumping in

the local qualifier offered at this regional, the competitor must complete and submit to the secretary the Tournament Eligibility Form in accordance with instructions on the form which will be available at the awards table.

NT Regional Qualification Information

PRE-QUALIFICATION INFORMATION FOR REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES

A dog must be entered in EITHER Championship OR Performance tournaments based upon qualification throughout the year - see tournament rules.
