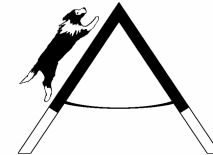

## NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

---

### USDAA® Rules

This event is sanctioned by the United States Dog Agility Association, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "USDAA".

This event will be held under the official rules and regulations of the USDAA. An electronic version of the rule book may be accessed online at [www.usdaa.com](http://www.usdaa.com).

Competitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules and regulations, as amended March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2007, which are hereby incorporated by reference, including, but not limited to the following rules and conditions for submission and acceptance of entry:

- This test is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.
- All dogs must be registered with USDAA in order to compete in USDAA sanctioned events. A registration form may be obtained at the USDAA's website, or you may go online to register at [www.usdaa.com](http://www.usdaa.com) prior to the show rate and obtain a registration number immediately and a measurement card prior to the show. Additionally, you may include your registration with entry to this show (a registration form is included in this test schedule).
- Handlers and dogs should be familiar with USDAA equipment. Training will not be allowed.
- Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.
- No leads, collars, toys, food or other training aids will be permitted on the course at any time.
- No slip (choke) or prong (pinch) collars are allowed in the ring or warm-up area.
- No shock collars will be allowed on the show grounds.
- The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee views that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing, must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and it's Organizing Committee.

---

### General

All entries must be received by **Friday, June 18<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm** after which time no entries will be accepted or cancelled.

A secondary closing date of **Monday, June 28<sup>th</sup> at 5:00pm** will be for advancement in level only for dogs entered by the closing date. Notification must be made in writing.

To be accepted, entries must be complete, signed (by parent or legal guardian if handler is a minor), received by the closing date and accompanied by the correct fees and include a valid USDAA registration number or a completed registration form.

You must present your USDAA cards during check-in. All dogs must be measured unless they are entered in 26" (22" Perf), the handler presents a permanent card, a completed temporary card awaiting a CMJ, a USDAA-issued check-in letter or print out of dog info page from subscriber account indicating the dog is permanently carded.

Check-in and measuring will be between 6:30am & 7:00am each day. All times are tentative and subject to change. Consult your entry confirmation for schedule changes.

Dogs and Handlers are not required to check in each day, just the first day of their weekend of competition.

---

### Release

Handlers through entry at this event accept full responsibility for themselves, their guests and the actions of their dogs.

All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of the United States Dog Agility Association.

Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at his event, ALL COMPETITORS and HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT to USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cable cast, transmission or distribution in any format or media known. All competitors and handlers hereby release USDAA and its representative, agents and assigns from any claims or cause of action for invasion of rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.

---

### Behavior

Competitors are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and children. Any competitor whose dogs or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site. No refund will be made.

Handlers caught not picking up after their dog may be asked to leave the show site and no refund will be made.

---

### Refunds

No refunds will be made after the closing date, or in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the judge or the club, or barred from competition by action of the Organizing Committee.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$20.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or short falls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler.

No entry fees will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.

There will be no refunds for overpayments of \$15.00 or less. Handlers caught not picking up after their dog may be asked to leave the show site and no refund will be made. Partial refunds for bitches in season and injured dogs will be made, provided you produce a signed letter from a licensed 3rd party veterinarian within 24 hours of the end of show; this does not include dogs that are injured during or after the trial.

**COMPETITION**

---

**General**

The test will be held indoors on ¾" horse stall matting covered with artificial turf.

There will be no equipment familiarization on any day, although warm-up jumps will be provided.

Fault limits may be imposed by the Organizing Committee and Judge and they will be announced during the Judge's briefing.

---

**Obstacles**

All obstacles at this event will meet USDAA specifications as outlined in Appendix A of the USDAA Rules and Regulations.

---

**Running Order**

Running order is determined by random draw.

Handlers with more than one dog in class will be separated whenever possible.

The handler of a dog entered in Team or Versatility Pairs that is required to jump a higher height by virtue of the judge's measurement must notify the secretary immediately. Should the higher jump height make the dog ineligible for their team (three jump heights), the secretary will make every effort to form complete teams from available dogs. The dog may not be moved to Versatility Pairs.

In the event the competitor is unprepared to run their dog at the higher jump height, they may run in the tournament For Exhibition Only. No member of the Team or Pair may earn a tournament qualification, but Team or Pairs partners are eligible for individual placements, tournament top ten points and Lifetime Achievement Qs in the individual tournament classes.

---

**Awards**

1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place rosettes will be awarded in each jump height for all test classes except Pairs where ribbons will be awarded to Mini and Open divisions.

A maroon qualifying ribbon will be awarded for those dogs earning qualifying scores.

Competitors must be present with dogs immediately following the class in which an award is earned in order to claim prizes and awards. All prizes and awards must be claimed on the day awarded, no awards will be mailed.

In addition, any variance from published height of A-Frame is due to angle as measured at the apex, and re-designed long jump will be used. The P8" dogs jump 2<sup>nd</sup> board only.

No dogs may be left unattended except when properly kenneled in designated kennel areas.

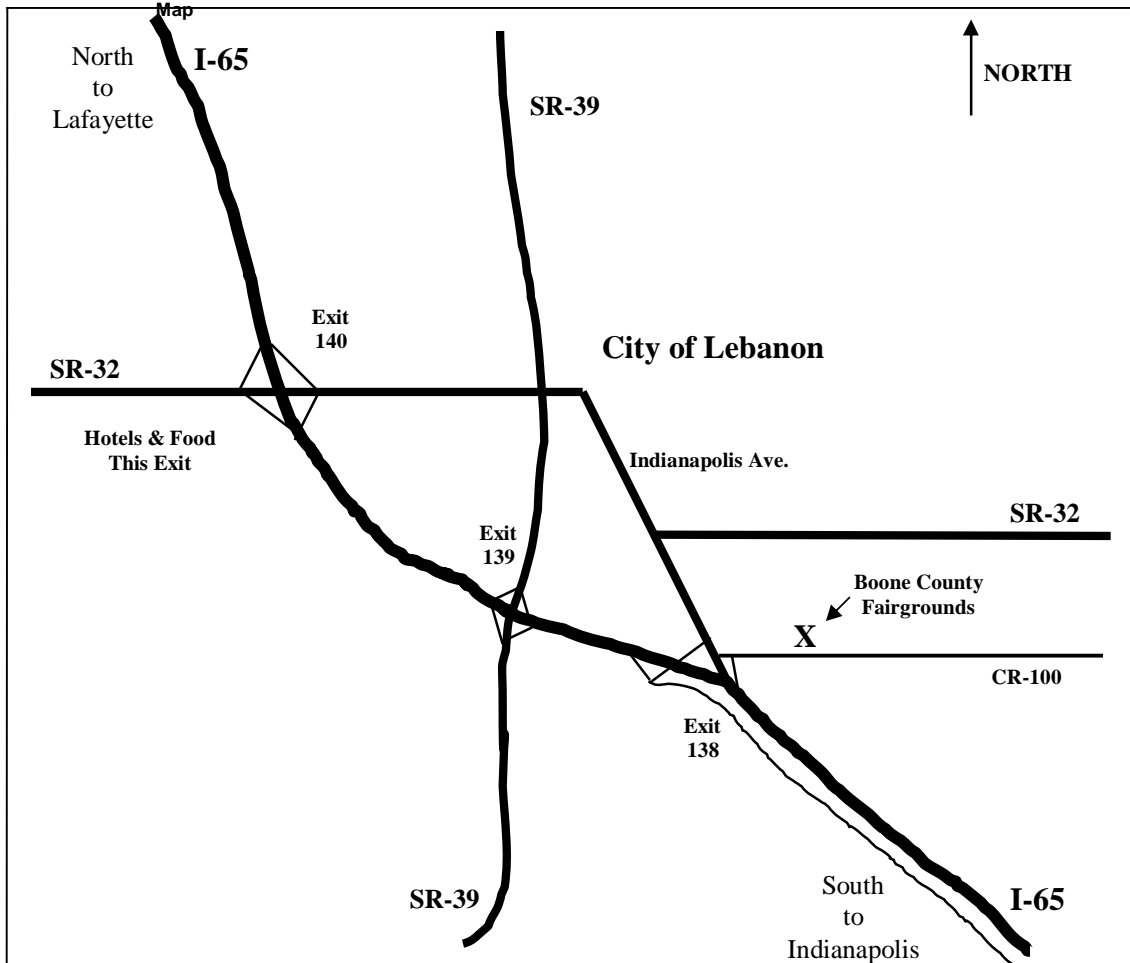

**CLASS DESCRIPTIONS and INFORMATION**

**General** Two certification programs will be offered at this event – Championship & Performance. Competitors may enter both Championship and Performance Program classes for which they are eligible. Classes include standard agility, gamblers, jumpers, pairs relay and snooker agility as set forth in Chapters 3 – 7 of USDAA Rules and Regulations, each of which are conducted at three competitive levels.

Under NO circumstance may a dog be entered in the same Championship and Performance class on the same day at this event. (Example: Standard at any level in both Championship & Performance)

**Championship** Please see the USDAA Rules & Regulations for details, Chapter 3-5, on the web at [http://www.usdaa.com/rulesReg\\_eBook.cfm](http://www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm).

**Performance** Please see the USDAA Rules & Regulations for details, Chapter 7, on the web at [http://www.usdaa.com/rulesReg\\_eBook.cfm](http://www.usdaa.com/rulesReg_eBook.cfm).

**Non-Standard** Non-Standard classes include **Gamblers, Jumpers, Snooker and Pairs**. These non-standard classes are scored and judged pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 6 -7 of the USDAA Rules & Regulations. Performance Pairs is required for titling at all levels as of 1/1/09. In the event only one dog is entered in a program/level, un-entered dogs or dogs from other programs/levels may not be recruited to form a qualifying pair.

**Tournament** To enter tournaments or tournament and test classes at different heights in the same program, you must submit a separate entry from. A dog may NOT be entered in both Grand Prix and Performance Grand Prix, Steeplechase and Performance Speed Jumping, Team, and Performance Versatility Pairs at this event.

The following Tournament classes are being offered at this event: (all competitors are eligible for entry to any of these tournament classes.) A copy of the tournament regulations for each tournament may be found on the USDAA website at [www.usdaa.com](http://www.usdaa.com).

**Grand Prix of Dog Agility® World Championships & Performance Grand Prix - Local Qualifiers**

These tournaments are open to all competitors regardless of titles earned or skill level. Both are a single-round tournament featuring the sport in its basic form. The course includes obstacles as set forth in Chapter 3 of USDAA Rules and Regulations for standard agility, except that no table obstacle shall be used. Standard scoring shall be applied. Competitors must have a ZERO fault round to earn a qualifying score for which qualifying ribbons are presented. One qualifying score is required for entry in Round 1 of a Regional Championships. Two qualifying scores required for entry into the quarterfinals at the World Championships.

Awards: Rosettes for 1st-3rd place in each jump height, "bye" voucher for first place qualifier in each jump height, qualifying ribbons for each qualifier.

**Dog Agility Steeplechase® Local Qualifier & Performance Speed Jumping<sup>SM</sup> Qualifier**

These tournaments are open to all dogs regardless of titles earned or level of competition. A dog may not be entered in both Steeplechase and Speed Jumping at this event. Steeplechase: One qualifying score as described in the complete rules is required for entry in a Regional Championships, and two are required for entry in the quarterfinals in the World Championships. Speed Jumping: Two qualifying scores as described in the complete rules are required for entry in the semifinals at the World Championships.

Awards: Prize money shall be computed based upon 30% of the total entry fees to be allocated in accordance with the payout table below regardless of the size of entry in any height class. Allocable amounts to finalist positions that are not filled for any reason or allocable prize amounts less than \$3.00 shall not be paid. Must be present the day of the trial, no awards will be mailed.

**Dog Agility Masters® Team Tournament and Performance Versatility Pairs<sup>SM</sup>**

A team is comprised of three handlers and dogs from any two Championship height classes. A pair may be comprised of dogs from any two performance height classes. The team/pair compete in five classes with each dog accumulating scores applied to the final score for the team/pair. One qualifying score as described in the complete rules is required for entry in the World Championships.

Awards: Each member of the top three teams/pairs overall will receive medallions. Each member of a qualifying team/pair will receive a lapel pin in recognition of their qualifying score.

A registration number with a “J” prefix will be assigned for use in entering UJHP events. A dog that is expected to compete in both programs (regular classes and UJHP) must be registered separately for each program. If registering for both programs at the same time the total fee is \$40.00.
