Jump Height Order

Championship Program: Friday – variable; Saturday – Tall to Small; Sunday – Tall to Small

Performance Program: Friday – variable; Saturday – Small -Tall; Sunday – Small -Tall

Note: Performance program will follow championship for each class on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Masters/PIII Snooker jump height order will be random each day..

Required Check-in and Measuring

Check-in is required, but if you include a copy of your permanent card with your entry, you do not need to present the card during check-in. Otherwise, you must present your permanent card, temporary card, or USDAA-issued check-in letter/ print our from subscriber page. All dogs without a permanent registration card, a completely signed temporary card, awaiting a CMJ, print out of dog-info sheet from subscriber account indicating the dog is permanently carded, or a check-in letter provided by the USDAA office MUST be measured

The handler of a dog entered in Team/PVP that measures up must notify the secretary at check-in. The secretary shall make every attempt to form complete teams from the dogs available. The dog measured up must jump at the higher height in order for the team/pair to earn a qualifying score. If the dog runs FEO at the lower height, the team/pair may not qualify, but the partners may earn placements, top ten points and LAA Qs in the individual classes. ! Please note: **measurement will only take place between 8:30 a.m.-9:00 a.m. Friday and 8:00 a.m. – 8:30 a.m. Saturday and Sunday**

DIRECTIONS TO TEST SITE

From Points South/East: Take I-40 West to I-440 (Beltline) to Exit 11 (Route 1 North / Capital Blvd). Continue on Route 1 North/Capital Blvd. until it splits at US-401. Follow US-401 North, which splits to the right. You will go through town of Rolesville and enter Franklin County. Pass Rte 96; turn right on 98 East (the next stoplight). Pass Spencer's Gate development. At first major road, turn right on Bethlehem Church Rd (road called Clifton Pond Rd on other side). Turn left onto Robbins Rd. Look for white fence on left. Turn left into second gravel driveway at Teamworks Dog Training sign.

From I-40 Headed East: Exit I-40 at I-540 West, toward Wake Forest. Continue on I-540 to the Louisburg/401 exit (exit #18). Make a left onto Rte 401 North. Continue on 401 North, going through the town of Rolesville. Pass Rte 96; enter Franklin County. Turn right onto 98 East (will be the next stoplight after crossing Rte 96). Pass Spencer's Gate development. At first major road, turn right on Bethlehem Church Rd (road called Clifton Pond Rd on other side). Turn left onto Robbins Rd. Look for white fence on left. Turn left into second gravel driveway at Teamworks Dog Training sign.

From Virginia and Points North of Raleigh: Take I-95 South to I-85 South. Follow Rte 1 South toward Raleigh. Take Rte 98 East to Wake Forest. Pass Spencer's Gate development. At first major road, turn right on Bethlehem Church Rd (road called Clifton Pond Road on other side). Turn left onto Robbins Rd. Look for the white fence on the left. Turn left into second gravel driveway at Teamworks Dog Training sign.

From Durham and Points West of Raleigh: Take I-85 North. Take US-70 East to Raleigh. Stay in the right hand lane. Watch for small sign for Rte 98 to Wake Forest (it comes up fast). Take Rte 98 East to Wake Forest. You will be on this road for about 40 minutes. Pass Route 50; pass Rte 1. Go through Wake Forest, turning to stay on Rte 98 East. Pass Rte 96. Pass Rte 401. Pass Spencer's Gate development. At first major road, turn right on Bethlehem Church Rd (called Clifton Pond Rd on other side). Turn left onto Robbins Rd Look for white fence on left. Turn left into second gravel driveway at Teamworks Dog Training sign.

Dogs must be registered with USDAA in order to compete in USDAA sanctioned events. A registration card and number with a "U" prefix will be issued to facilitate entry at USDAA events and tracking of show results in the regular classes.

Junior handlers (those 18 years of age and younger) and their dogs must be separately registered for participation in the USDAA's Junior Handler Program (UJHP). A registration number with a "J" prefix will be assigned for use in entering UJHP events. A dog competing in both programs (regular classes and UJHP) must be registered separately for each program, for which the total fee is \$37.00.

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the USDAA Rules and Regulations as amended July 1, 2009 . A rule book may be viewed online at www.usdaa.com.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS & ELIGIBILITY

The following titling classes are being offered at the Starters, PI, Advanced, PII, Masters, and PIII levels at this event:

Standard, Gamblers, Jumpers, Pairs Relay, and Snooker

A complete description of these classes and the requirements for eligibility for entry may be found in Chapters 3-7 of Official USDAA Rules & Regulations, which are incorporated in this test schedule by reference. A summary of eligibility requirements for all titling classes is presented in Appendix E of the Rules & Regulations. Competitors may enter both Championship and Performance classes for which they may be eligible; however, no dog may be entered in the same class regardless of level at this event.

Performance Pairs is now required for titling at all levels of Performance and follows the same rules as for the Championship Program. In either program, should only one dog be entered in a level/program, unentered dog or dogs from other programs/levels may NOT be recruited to form a qualifying pair.

The following Tournament classes are being offered at this event: NOTE: all competitors are eligible for entry to any of these tournament classes.

Dog Agility Masters® Team and **Performance Versatility PairsSM** – A team may be comprised of dogs from any two Championship height classes. A pair may be comprised of dogs from any two Performance height classes. One qualifying score as described in the complete rules is required for entry in the World Championships.

Grand Prix of Dog Agility® and **Performance Grand PrixSM** - A qualifying score is zero faults. One Q is required for entry in a Regional Championships. Two qualifying scores are required for entry in the quarterfinals at the World Championships.

Dog Agility Steeplechase® and **Performance Speed JumpingSM - Steeplechase:** One qualifying score as described in the complete rules is required for entry in a Regional Championships, and two are required for entry in the quarterfinals at the World Championships. **Speed Jumping:** Two qualifying scores as described in the complete rules are required for entry in the semifinals at the World Championships.

AWARDS

Titling Classes – Ribbons and small prizes will be awarded to dog/handler teams placing 1st through 4th place in all classes in their respective jump heights and in mini and open divisions for pairs. Maroon qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score in any non-tournament classes. Rainbow colored rosettes will be awarded to those finishing a title.

Dog Agility Masters® Team and **Performance Versatility PairsSM** – Prizes and awards will be made based upon overall team scores after five rounds. USDAA will provide “Gold”, “Silver” & “Bronze” medallions at local qualifying events for the three top scoring teams/pairs. Qualifying lapel pins will be awarded to each member of each qualifying team or pair.

Grand Prix of Dog Agility® and **Performance Grand PrixSM** - The first place qualifying handler/dog team in each height class shall earn a “bye” voucher, permitting them to enter or directly advance to the final round of a regional championship. A double maroon and white ribbon shall be awarded to all qualifiers in the Grand Prix, with a double maroon and pink ribbon awarded to all qualifiers in the Performance Grand Prix. Rosettes for 1st – 4th place will be awarded for each jump height.

Dog Agility Steeplechase® - Prize money shall be computed based upon 30% of the total entry fees to be allocated in accordance with the payout table on the following page regardless of the size of entry in any height class.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors through submission of an entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules & regulations, including but not limited to the following rules regarding entry:

This test is open to all dogs being at least eighteen (18) months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression towards people or other dogs.

All dogs must be registered with USDAA in order to compete in sanctioned events. Registration may be made concurrently with entry by including the dog registration application with your entry. To receive a registration number immediately and a measurement card prior to the show, go to www.usdaa.com, click on General Information, and click on Dog Registration.

No leads, collars, food, toys, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.

Safety shall always be of foremost consideration in actions and conduct by handlers at all times.

The organizing committee may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee view that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its organizing committee.

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the original closing date, or in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judges, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. In addition, no entry fees will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of god, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the club. Exception: bitches in heat may be withdrawn and the entry fee (less our direct costs plus a \$5 processing fee) returned upon request of the competitor prior to the opening of the trial. **Request must be accompanied by a veterinarian's statement.**

Refunds for overpayments of \$5 or less will not be made.

Partial refunds for entries withdrawn after closing minus expenses will be granted for bitches in heat and injured dogs. All such requests must be made in writing prior to the first day of the trial and be accompanied by a veterinarian's note verifying the dog's condition.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$35 service charge for returned checks. Amounts shall be paid within 30 days of postmarked notice of returned check if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse.

This event will be held outdoors in two rings, one on packed sand and one on grass. There is ample room for parking and crating.

A single practice jump will be provided for competitors.

All dogs must be held on leash except when being judged or when using the warm up jump.

No dogs may be left unattended except when properly kenneled in designated kennel areas. Day kenneling only is permitted, unless otherwise posted at the show site. USDAA and Teamworks Dog Training cannot and do not assume any liability for loss of any items left unattended.

It is expressly understood that competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. A competitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the test site.

Fault limits may be set at the discretion of the organizing committee and judge; if imposed, they will be announced during the judges' briefings.

Food will be available at the show site.

Dogs must be exercised only in designated areas. **Please clean up after your dog** at the trial site and at your motel.

Express mail entries must include a signature waiver.

All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of United States Dog Agility Association, Inc.

Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at this event, ALL COMPETITORS and HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT to USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media now known. All competitors and handlers hereby release USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.
