### Entries and Closing

Entries must be received by Saturday, July 31, no later than 6 pm and accompanied by the correct fees (**payable to Fleet Feet** in U.S. Funds only). For entries received by July 31, advancements in level due to titles earned will be accepted until Noon, Monday, August 16. These changes must be made in writing and sent by email to the secretary at [fleetfeetdogagility@yahoo.com](mailto:fleetfeetdogagility@yahoo.com). If a phone message is left, it must be followed up in writing by the secondary closing time. No other changes will be made after the secondary closing date. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry shall be refunded in event of such errors, or cancellation of such entries after the closing date. **Please type or print carefully the information on the entry forms to prevent errors.**

**IMPORTANT:** If entry is sent overnight, **you must sign the waiver to allow delivery without signature.** There will be no one available to sign for packages and Fleet Feet is not responsible for entries delayed in delivery. Fleet Feet reserves the right to refuse entries received after the closing date due to not signing the signature waiver.

### PRIZES AND AWARDS

All prizes and awards must be claimed on the day awarded.

#### Championship & Performance Titling Classes

1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> Ribbons in each jump height for all classes. Pairs will be awarded 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> in "mini" and "open" divisions. Maroon rosettes will be available for all qualifying scores.

#### Tournament Classes

##### Grand Prix/Performance GP

1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> Rosettes in each jump height for each tournament. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded for all qualifying scores. Bye vouchers will not be awarded pursuant to tournament rules.

#### Steeplechase

1st-4th Ribbons in each jump height in Round 2

Prize money shall be computed based upon 30% of the total entry fees to be allocated in accordance with the payout table below regardless of the size of entry in any height class.

### Check-In & Tentative Start Times

Check-in and measuring is from 7:15 am to 7:45 am each day. Check final confirmation notice for updates. Times may change due to entry numbers.

You may mail in a copy of your PERMANENT CARD (NO BLUE CARDS) to expedite check-in. **Dogs requiring measurement should arrive early.** All dogs must be measured prior to being checked in their first day of competition UNLESS the dog jumps 26" (22" Perf), the handler has sent a copy of the permanent card or presents the permanent card, a temporary card with 3 signatures awaiting a CMJ or check-in letter issued by USDAA / print out of dog info page from subscriber account indicate the dog is permanently carded. All competitors should have their measurement cards with them at check-in so that registration numbers can be verified.

## NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- Competitors through submission of entry acknowledge that they are knowledgeable USDAA® rules and regulations as amended July 1, 2009. A copy of USDAA®'s official rules & regulations may be viewed online at [www.usdaa.com](http://www.usdaa.com).
- This test is open to all dogs being at least eighteen (18) months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting sign of aggression.
- **All dogs entered must be registered** with a "U" registration number to participate in the Championship/Performance and Tournament classes, "J" registration numbers will NOT be accepted. Register online at [www.usdaa.com](http://www.usdaa.com), click on General Information/Dog Registration to receive a registration number immediately and a height card prior to the test. Registration may be made concurrently with entry to this test, a form for which is included in this Agility Test Schedule. Add the registration fee to your entry fee and make checks payable to CVAC.
- Change of jump heights will be made ONLY when the dog is required to move to a higher category by the judge's measurement. The handler can decide to run For Exhibition Only at the lower height; however, no qualifying scores or awards may be earned and no change in program is permitted at check-in.
- All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of United States Dog Agility Association®, Inc.
- **Portions of this event may be taped for television.** . Through entry at this event, ALL COMPETITORS and HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT to USDAA® and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media now known. All competitors and handlers hereby release USDAA® and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.
- Fault Limits may be imposed by the Organizing Committee and/or judge and will be announced in the judge's briefing
- Agility obstacles shall meet the requirements of USDAA® rules and regulations. There will be no equipment familiarization on the day of the test. A small warm-up area and a single practice jump will be provided for dogs entered in the show. No other equipment or training devices will be allowed on the show grounds the day of the test.
- No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.
- The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this test, competitors acknowledge that they are familiar with and able to perform obstacles safely.
- **Entry Fee Policy:** Declined payments (i.e. "insufficient funds" and/or otherwise a "bad check") that come to our attention following the closing date but prior to the event must be paid in-full before the event begins. Failure to do so will automatically result in loss of right to show at the event. Where declined payments come to our attention following the event, entry fees and/or registrations must be paid in full, including any NSF charges, and must be received by the test secretary within 30 days following the event date or the receipt of notice of declined payment, whichever is later. Payment shall be in the form of cash, money order or cashier's check. Failure to settle delinquent payments shall result in automatic cancellation of event results, and all prizes and awards shall be returned for distribution to the valid winners or registration numbers will be suspended from further competition until .such time as any awards are returned. Under no circumstances shall the "canceled results" be reinstated.

- **There shall be no refunds** for entries withdrawn after the closing date except as indicated below, or in the event that a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. In addition, no entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God (including weather that the Organizing Committee in its sole determination shall deem unsafe), public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.
- **REFUNDS AFTER CLOSING DATE ARE OFFERED ONLY IN THE CASE OF AN INJURY TO THE DOG. Requests must be accompanied by a note from a veterinarian. THE TOTAL FEE MINUS Fees paid to USDAA WILL BE REFUNDED.**
- Any competitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Organizing Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fee will be made.
- The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for Just cause should the committee views that participation by competitor or dog would be, prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host, group and its Organizing Committee.
- ALL Dogs present must be held on leash or otherwise confined except when being judged or in the Warm Up area. If you are caught in violation with this rule, you will be excused from the Test.
- Test will be run outdoors on grass, rain or shine. Hose/water will be available. There is ample room for crating, tents, and chairs outdoors. Please be advised to bring proper equipment to shade your dog or otherwise shelter your dog, in case of inclement weather.
- There may or may not be a food vendor available on site. Competitors are urged to bring their own lunches. Fast food restaurants and shopping are available within five miles of the site.

### CLASS DESCRIPTIONS & ELIGIBILITY

The following titling classes are being offered at the Starters, PI, Advanced, PII, levels at this event:

#### Standard, Gamblers, Jumpers, Pairs Relay, and Snooker

Only **Gamblers** and **Snooker** titling classes will be offered at the **Masters/PIII** level

A complete description of these classes and the requirements for eligibility for entry may be found in Chapters 3-7 of Official USDAA Rules & Regulations, which are incorporated in this test schedule by reference. A summary of eligibility requirements for all titling classes is presented in Appendix E of the Rules & Regulations. Competitors may enter both Championship and Performance classes for which they may be eligible; however, no dog may be entered in the same class regardless of level at this event.

- Performance Pairs is required for titling as of 1/1/09, and follows the same rules as for the Championship Program. In either program, should only one dog be entered in a level/program, un-entered dog or dogs from another program/level may NOT be recruited to form a qualifying pair.

### Tournaments

The following Tournament classes are being offered at this event: NOTE: all competitors are eligible for entry to any of these tournament classes. A copy of the tournament regulations for each tournament may be viewed on the USDAA website at [www.usdaa.com](http://www.usdaa.com).

**Grand Prix of Dog Agility®** and **Performance Grand Prix<sup>SM</sup>** – Single-round tournaments open to all dogs regardless of titles earned or level of competition. A qualifying score is ZERO faults. Complete rules will be available at the show site and at [www.usdaa.com](http://www.usdaa.com). NOTE: When a local qualifier is held in conjunction with an agility test where all levels of titling are NOT being offered, 'bye' vouchers will not be awarded.

- One Q is required for entry in a Regional Championships. Two qualifying scores are required for entry in the quarterfinals at the World Championships.

**Dog Agility Steeplechase®** and **Performance Speed Jumping<sup>SM</sup>** - Two-round tournaments open to all dogs regardless of titles earned or level of competition. **Steeplechase:** One qualifying score as described in the complete rules is required for entry in a Regional Championships, and two are required for entry in the quarterfinals at the World Championships. **Speed Jumping:** Two qualifying scores as described in the complete rules are required for entry in the semifinals at the World Championships.
