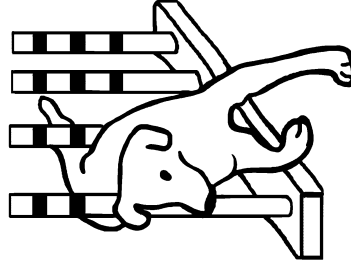

ENTRIES AND CLOSING DATES

Entries must be received by **Friday, January 29th @ 5:00 pm**. NO cancellations, additions or refund requests shall be permitted after the closing date of Friday, January 29th @ 5:00 pm. You may advance the level of your entry (those received by closing) until noon on Monday, February 8.

All dogs must be registered with a "U" prefix. If your dog is not registered you may do so concurrently with entry or online at www.usdaa.com.

Telephoned or e-mailed entries without appropriate fees cannot be accepted. All entries must be in writing and either mailed or presented in person, with appropriate fees, to Monica Wilson Test Secretary, by the closing date.

IMPORTANT. If you send an entry by overnight mail, you **must** sign the waiver allowing delivery without signature. There will be no one available to sign for packages and Dog Gone Fun Agility will not be responsible for entries delayed in delivery. Dog Gone Fun Agility reserves the right to refuse entries received after the closing date due to not signing the signature waiver

All times are tentative. Check final confirmation notice for updates. Times and or class schedule may change due to entry numbers.

You may mail in a copy of your PERMANENT CARD (NO BLUE CARDS) to expedite check-in. Handlers need only check in dogs their first day of competition. ALL DOGS must be measured prior to being checked in UNLESS the dog is entered in 26" (22" Perf), a copy of the permanent card was submitted with entry, the handler presents a permanent card, a temporary card with 3 signatures awaiting a CMJ, a USDAA-issued check-in letter or print out from dog info page from subscriber account indicating the dog is permanently carded. In the event a dog is measured up to a height for which it is unprepared, it may be run For Exhibition Only at the lower height, but no awards or qualifying scores may be earned and no change in program is permitted. Dogs requiring measurement should arrive early. All competitors should have their measurement cards with them at check-in so that registration numbers can be verified.

Move-ups

Move-ups will be allowed only with a day in-between. Friday to Sunday. If you earn a title on Friday, you will be allowed to move up that dog for Sunday's run. Please check your dogs' previous results carefully to ensure you are eligible to move up at this trial based upon qualifying scores earned and the judges from whom these scores were earned. Confirm your score with the scorekeeper and the judge at the conclusion of a class ensure the qualifying score you have been awarded has been accurately calculated in accordance with the regulations. If for any reason it is determined you were ineligible for the higher class level, any awards will be forfeited and entry deemed to be null and void without refund or recourse. Move-up forms will be available at the awards table and must be turned in on Friday.

OBSTACLES

Obstacles shall be chosen from those described in the current edition of the USDAA Rules and Regulations. Please note that if you have purchased access to the Subscriber Services area on the USDAA website, you may print a complete copy of the regulations as included in the Subscriber Services Forms & Documents Library at no charge.

CLASS DESCRIPTIONS & ELIGIBILITY

Competitors may enter both Championship and Performance test classes at this event, but no dog may be entered in the same class in both programs. The following titling classes are being offered at the Starters, PI, Advanced, PII, Masters, and PIII levels at this event:

Standard, Gamblers, Jumpers, Pairs Relay, and Snooker

A complete description of these classes and the requirements for eligibility for entry may be found in Chapters 3-7 of Official USDAA Rules & Regulations, which are incorporated in this test schedule by reference. A summary of eligibility requirements for all titling classes is presented in Appendix E of the Rules & Regulations.

Pairs is REQUIRED for titling in all levels of Performance. Partners for both Championship and Performance Pairs must be from the same level and height division, mini (Ch 12/16, Perf 8/12) or open (Ch 22/26, Perf 16/22). Eligibility is determined by either the highest Versatility or Relay title earned. Crossing over from Championship is the same as for other classes. A handler may opt to enter Level 1 provided that a qualifying score in a higher level Performance relay class has not been earned. In the event only one dog is entered in a program/level, dog not entered in relay or dogs from other programs/levels may not be recruited to form a qualifying pair.

The following Tournament classes are being offered at this event: (all competitors are eligible for entry to any of these tournament classes.) A copy of the tournament regulations for each tournament may be found on the USDAA website at www.usdaa.com.

Grand Prix of Dog Agility® World Championships & Performance Grand PrixSM - Local Qualifiers

These tournaments are open to all competitors regardless of titles earned or skill level. Both are a single-round tournament featuring the sport in its basic form. The course includes obstacles as set forth in Chapter 3 of USDAA Rules and Regulations for standard agility, except that no table obstacle shall be used. Standard scoring shall be applied. Competitors must have a ZERO fault round to earn a qualifying score for which qualifying ribbons are presented. One qualifying score is required for entry in Round 1 of a Regional Championships. Two qualifying scores required for entry into the quarterfinals at the World Championships.

Dog Agility Steeplechase® Local Qualifier & Performance Speed JumpingSM Qualifier

These tournaments are open to all dogs regardless of titles earned or level of competition. A dog may not be entered in both Steeplechase and Speed Jumping at this event. Steeplechase: One qualifying score as described in the complete rules is required for entry in a Regional Championships, and two are required for entry in the quarterfinals in the World Championships. Speed Jumping: Two qualifying scores as described in the complete rules is required for entry in the semifinals at the World Championships.

AWARDS

Titling Classes - Ribbons for 1st through 4th place will be awarded in each jump height (and for mini and open in pairs). Maroon qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs earning a qualifying score in any non-tournament classes. Title Ribbons will also be available. Dog Toys will be awarded for each placement.

Grand Prix and Performance Grand Prix - The first place qualifying handler/dog team in each height class shall earn a “bye” voucher, permitting them to directly advance to the final round of a regional championship. First through Fourth place Ribbons will be awarded. A double maroon and white ribbon shall be awarded to all qualifiers in the Grand Prix, with a double maroon and pink ribbon awarded to all qualifiers in the Perf. National Standard.

Dog Agility Steeplechase® - Prize money shall be computed based upon 30% of the total entry fees to be allocated in accordance with the payout table below regardless of the size of entry in any height class.

NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules and regulations, as amended July 1, 2009 which are hereby incorporated by reference, including but not limited to the following rules and conditions for submission and acceptance of entry:

This test is open to all dogs at least eighteen months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness that might affect the dog's physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.

All dogs must be registered with USDAA in order to compete in USDAA sanctioned events. Registration may be made concurrently with entry to this show, a form for which is included in this agility test schedule. To obtain a registration number immediately and a height card prior to the show go online to www.usdaa.com, General Information, Dog Registration. Dogs that "measure up" during measuring may choose to run for exhibition only (non-qualifying) at the lower height; however, no awards or qualifying scores may be earned. NO change in program at check-in is allowed.

No leads, collars, food, toys or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.

Safety shall always be of foremost consideration at all times. Handlers through entry at this event accept full responsibility for themselves and the actions of their dogs.

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee views that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

Fault limits may be imposed in any class to which they apply at the discretion of the organizing committee and judge.

Competition is being held indoors, on a packed dirt surface. Bathrooms are inside. Crating area will be provided indoors. Crates may be left at the site on Wednesday through Saturday night, but all live animals must be removed from the premises. The site cannot be locked, so entrants are responsible for securing any valuables. Dog Gone Fun Agility will not be liable for any loss due to theft, natural disasters, vandalism and Acts of God.

Please observe any posted or verbal regulations regarding parking and set up. If you have questions, ask a Dog Gone Fun Agility representative.

Dogs must remain on leash at all times, except when competing in the ring. You must clean up after your dogs.

It is the responsibility of the competitor to have his/her dog ready to compete and at the ring entrance when the steward calls. Handlers and dogs should be familiar with USDAA[®] equipment. There will be no warm-up period before testing begins.

No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God (including weather that the Organizing Committee in its sole determination shall deem unsafe), public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.

It is the entrant's responsibility to check for errors before submitting entry forms to this club. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for returned checks. Payment of entry fees and service charges shall be made in cash or money order within 30 days of postmark of notice of returned check where notification is received after event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice will result in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler.

Amounts overpaid on entry fees of \$10.00 or less shall not be refunded.

All Competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of United States Dog Agility Association, Inc.

Portions of this event may be taped for television. Through entry at this event, ALL Competitors AND HANDLERS HERBY GRANT to USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media now known. All competitors and handlers hereby release USDAA and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.

Competitors (handler or their dog) may not enter any class held for title under a judge who resides in the same household or with whom they have trained in the past ten (10) days.
