Entries & Closing Date:

Entries must be received signed with appropriate fees no later than 9 p.m. Wednesday, February 17. There is no secondary closing for advancement in level. No cancellations, additions or refund requests shall be permitted after the closing date. Telephone, faxed, or emailed entries without appropriate fees cannot be accepted.

All entries must be in writing and either mailed or presented in person, with appropriate fees, to Michelle Gross, Test Secretary, by the closing date. Think Pawsitive, LLC will not be held liable for delays in mail. Entries sent via Fed-X, or Express Mail will only be accepted if the waiver allowing delivery without signature is signed. Think Pawsitive, LLC will not be responsible for entries delayed in delivery. Think Pawsitive, LLC reserves the right to refuse entries received after the closing date due to not signing the signature waiver. Checks will be deposited upon receipt.

There is no limit to the number of dogs that can participate in this agility trial.

Notice to cancel your entry must be received in writing via email at Michelle@thinkpawsitivedog.com prior to the closing date of February 17, 2010. There will be no refunds of entry fees for cancellations after the closing date for any reason. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$30.00 service charge for returned checks. Amounts shall be paid within 30 days of postmarked notice of returned check if such date follows the event date. Any fees not received within 30 days of notice results in cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number(s) of delinquent entry/entries. No reinstatement of results is possible, and all awards must be returned within 10 days of notification, or the dog's registration number may be suspended pending restitution. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse.

Entry fee over-payments of \$10.00 or less will not be refunded.

The Organizing Committee of this event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee view that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee doing so must notify the competitor in writing, with a copy to the USDAA office, in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for the decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and Organizing Committee.

Check-in is required. Handlers need only check in dogs their first day of competition. Dogs requiring measurement should arrive early. All dogs must be measured prior to being checked in unless the dog jumps 26" (P22"), the handler presents a permanent card, temporary card with 3 signatures awaiting a CMJ or check-in letter issued by USDAA/print out of dog info page indicating the dog is permanently carded. Registration numbers must be verified at check-in.

A dog that measures up will run first in the higher jump height. If it is unprepared to jump the higher height, the dog may run For Exhibition Only, but no awards or qualifying scores may be earned and no change in program is permitted.

Notice to Competitors

Competitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules and regulations, as amended July 1, 2009. The complete rules are available online at www.usdaa.com.

This test is open to all dogs at least eighteen months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs with any deformity, injury, or illness that could affect their physical or mental performance, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.

All dogs must be registered with USDAA® in order to compete in USDAA® sanctioned events. To obtain a registration number and a height card prior to the show, go online to www.usdaa.com, Competitor Services, First Time Dog Registrants. Registration may also be included with your entry to this event, by completing the form included in this premium and submitting it with the required fees.

No leads, collars, food, toys, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time.

Safety shall always be of foremost consideration. Handlers, through entry at this event, accept full responsibility for themselves, their dogs and/or children. Any competitor whose dog and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may be asked to leave the show site and no fees paid will be refunded.

Fault limits may be imposed at the discretion of the organizing committee and/or the judge in classes to which they apply and will be announced in the judges' briefings. Agility obstacles shall meet the requirements of USDAA® rules and regulations.

All competitors through entry at this event waive any and all rights relative to video broadcast of this event. Competitors shall have the right to videotape portions of this event for their personal use only. No portion of this event may be videotaped for commercial or other purposes. All video, broadcast and telecast rights for this event are the exclusive property of United States Dog Agility Association®, Inc. Through entry at this event ALL COMPETITORS and HANDLERS HEREBY GRANT to USDAA® and its representatives, agents and assigns, all rights and permission to use or appropriate his/her and their dog's name, biography, likeness, photograph, voice, performing persona, or other indicia of identity for broadcast, telecast, cablecast, transmission or distribution in any format or media now known or hereafter to become known. All competitors and handlers hereby release USDAA® and its representatives, agents and assigns from any claim or cause of action for invasion of the rights of privacy, right of publicity, right of personality, or any similar right.

This trial will have one ring: indoors on packed dirt. Competitors must be present at the ring gate when called. There will be no familiarization period. A warm-up jump will be set up outside the arena.

There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God (including weather that the Organizing Committee in its sole determination shall deem unsafe), public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.

Dogs and/or handlers may not enter any class held for title under a judge who resides in the same household or with whom the handler affiliates through training classes within the previous ten day period.

Dogs must remain on leash at all times, except when competing in the ring.

There is ample parking and crating space on site.

Food and beverages will be available on site.

Please pick up after your dog!

Programs Offered

Two certification programs will be offered at this event: Championship and Performance. Competitors may enter both Championship and Performance Program classes for which they are eligible; however, under NO circumstances may a dog be entered in the same Championship and Performance class on the same day at this agility test (i.e. Standard at any level in both programs).

Championship Program

Starters Level: See Chapter 5 of the USDAA Rule book.

Advanced Level: See Chapter 4 of the USDAA Rule book.

Masters Level: See Chapter 3 of the USDAA Rule book.

Performance Program

Classes are offered at Level I, Level II and Level III.

Performance Dog I: See Chapter 7 of the USDAA Rule book.

Performance Dog II: See Chapter 7 of the USDAA Rule book.

Performance Dog III: See Chapter 7 of the USDAA Rule book.

Non-Standard Classes

Gamblers Class: consists of a course with no pre-determined route and each obstacle is assigned a point value. In the 'opening' period the handler seeks to accumulate points by performing the obstacles of his/her choice in the time allotted. At the conclusion of the 'opening' the handler attempts the 'gamble,' as a sequence designated by the judge to be handled from a distance, for additional points.

Jumpers Class: consists of a course of jumps and may include a tire and tunnels.

Snooker Class: has an opening sequence of point collection similar to Gamblers followed by a closing sequence of a set pattern. Roughly parallels the billiards game of 'Snooker.'

Pairs Relay: consists of a standard course with one dog and handler running a portion of the course, followed by a baton exchange to a second handler and dog who run the second portion of the course. Partners must be from the same level and height division, mini (CH 12/16", Perf 8/12") or open (CH 22/26", Perf 16/22"). Should only one dog be entered in a program/level, dogs not entered in the class or in that program/level may not be recruited to form a qualifying pair.
