How to Report Your Scores

USDAA and World Cynosport Rally Limited (WCRL) have combined to develop USDAA@Home! as a platform for participation in their respective programs. This document addresses how to report scores for enrolled events.

To report scores, go to your Dashboard on USDAA@Home! and open the accordion list of My Active Courses. Here you will see a *Submit Results* link for each course.

Once uploaded, a judge will review the performance and make any corrections to the reported results. Successful completion of the performance measured against the standards will be reflected with a “Y” or “N” in the Approval column on your dashboard, and the results will automatically move to the My Completed Courses section, as well as be posted to your competition results page in Competitor Services. The course will appear in the My Completed Courses section for 30 days.

DOG AGILITY

For each course, enter—

- enter the actual jump height your dog jumped on the course (see USDAA@Home! Agility Regulations for eligible heights),
- the estimated time for the performance to the 100th of a second (e.g., forty-five and 32/100th seconds is 45.23; 1:15.06 as 75.06 seconds), and
- the score as you determine based upon USDAA Rules & Regulations, and as may be modified by the course requirements, as follows:
 - Standard & Jumping - Scores are "fault-based", where a score of 0.00 (or "0") indicates a zero-fault round. If five faults incurred, enter Score as 5, if 10 faults, enter 10, and so on. USDAA will evaluate SCT on pass/fail basis, so no time penalties need to be calculated.
 - Gamblers & Snooker - Scores are "point-based", where a score is the total number of points earned in the time allowed. Note that no points are awarded for the "closing" joker. The Joker will be evaluated on a pass/fail basis.

RALLY

For each course,

- enter the actual Jump Height your dog jumped; if no are jumps used on the course, enter zero ("0"),
- enter estimated time to the hundredths of a second (e.g., 45.23), and
- enter your score as follows:
 - Enter a score as total possible points minus any penalties incurred for infractions as listed in WCRL Rules & Regulations (e.g., 200 total possible points for a full course, minus 12 points in penalties, equals 188.00 points to be recorded.)

NEED TO MAKE CORRECTIONS?

Results, as well as any corrections to your score or video must be uploaded by the due date and time shown on your dashboard. To make a correction after a previous upload, go to your Dashboard on USDAA@Home! If your score has not already been judged (“Q” column is empty), then an X with link to delete that result is active. Delete and resubmit all information, including the video link, before the deadline. Should you have any difficulties, email USDAAatHome@usdaa.com.

Once deleted, information cannot be recovered from USDAA@Home! Be sure that you retain a copy of your results and your video link in case of accidental deletion.
