



Rally Scoring Abbreviations

Following are the scoring abbreviations used in judging notes for rally obedience:

1 Point

- A:** Anticipation of a cue
- B:** Bumping while heeling
- Bk:** Barking episode
- C:** Crooked sit, stand, down, or front (each 30 degrees)
- F:** Forging while heeling
- Jp:** Jumping on handler
- L:** Lagging while heeling
- MPOP:** Moving Partially Out of Place
- MU:** Not Moving in Unison
- OOP:** Out of Place sit, stand, down, or front
- SH:** Significant Hesitation
- TL:** Tight Leash
- W:** Wide while heeling

2 Points

- >4:** Initiating exercise out of approximate 4' sign radius
- AC:** Additional Cue
- AP:** Adapting Pace
- Desc:** Failure to Perform as Described (other than a Primary Element)
- DF:** Handler Dropping Food in the ring
- DL:** Dropping Leash while performing course
- MOP:** Moving Out of Place more than 50% of footprint
- Sign:** Displacing or Splitting a Sign
- XS/XD:** Extra Sit, Down, or Stand when not required

3 Points

- LoC:** Temporary Loss of Control
- RT:** Retry of an exercise or shared station

5 Points

- PE:** Incorrect Performance of a Primary Element
- RSS:** Rewarding in Shared Station for Shared Element (Intro only)
